

Reducing the number of courseworks for DMMR 2018/19

- DMMR coursework is 15% of the overall mark (with the exam 85%). For the coursework, students answer and hand in the final question on the weekly tutorial sheet (weeks 2 to 10) on the Wednesday which is marked by their tutor and returned at the tutorial in the following week.
- Given the complexities of both administering the weekly exercises and providing feedback, we think it would be easier for students, tutors, markers, teaching staff and ITO to have a smaller number of hand ins.
- The lecture course is in two halves and so we propose two hand ins each with five questions to be submitted early week 5 and early week 10. We propose that each hand in is worth $7\frac{1}{2}\%$ of the overall course. Markers (who are not necessarily tutors) will be recruited to mark these exercises.
- There will still be weekly tutorial sheets and students will still be encouraged to answer all questions in advance of the tutorials.
