1. **New appointments:** MSc selection team: Jacques Fleuriot (AI), Kousha Etesami (Informatics), Boris Grot (CS), led by Ajitha Rajan as PGT Admissions Officer
2. **Recruitment Committee:** met 1st November
3. **Minimum offer 2017:** SQA Higher AABB (by end of S5) AABBB or AAAB (S4-S6) (from ABBB)
4. **Clearing this year** - small numbers through this
5. **Meeting with College 10/November - discussed managing numbers and improving quality.**
 - a. agreed to pilot the MSc fee deposit for 2017/18 (still to sort mechanisms)
 - b. move to gathered field for MSc, with immediate effect (some offers already made)
 - c. more rigid interpretation of the maths +programming requirements for MSc entry
 - d. use of personal statements to assess suitability, esp for MSc Des Inf.
 - e. make case to college for increasing English Language requirements for Des Inf MSc, in line with other CHSS, for 2018 entry
 - f. aim for MSc cohort of 300 to 350 for 2017/18, with improved quality +better predictability.
 - g. aim for similar cohort in future years, but with progressively improving quality.
 - h. undertake a review of MSc entry qualifications (including English) and outcome and bring forward any further proposals for changes for 2018/19.

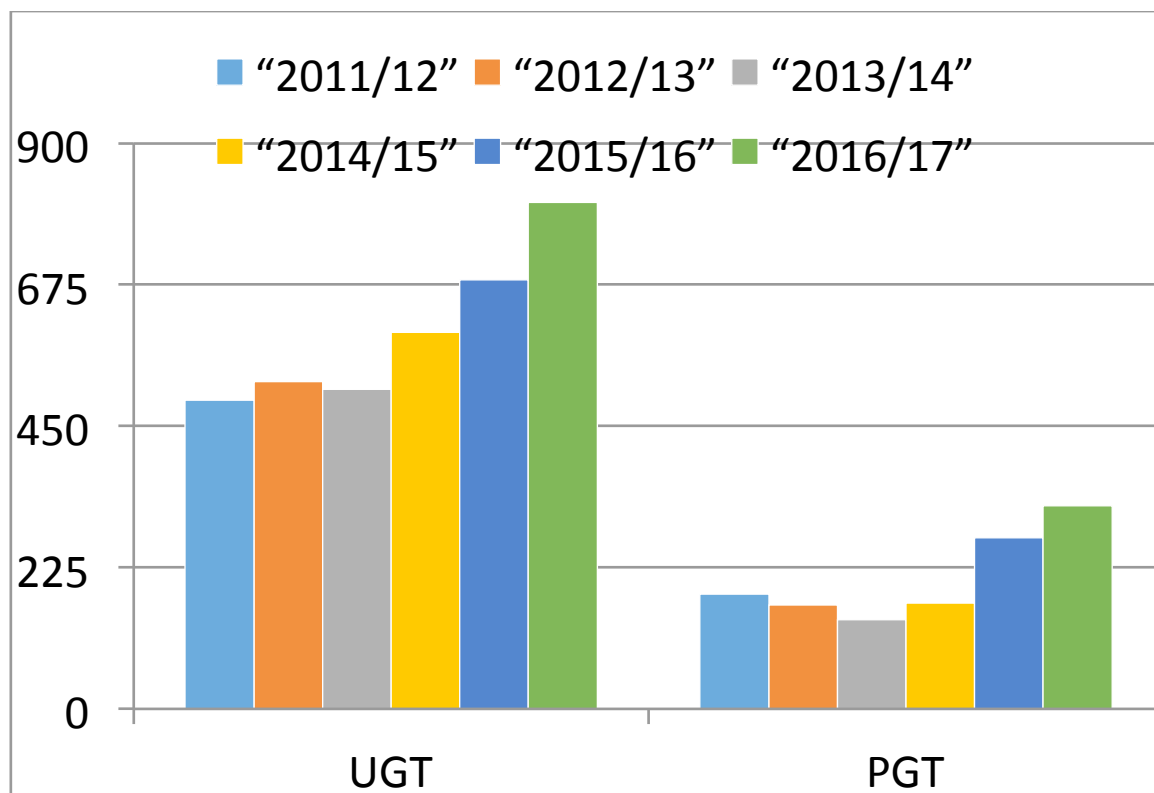
