
Creating a PURE entry by import from file

Importing data from file, e.g. BibTeX


1 Log in to Pure.

https://www.pure.ed.ac.uk/

Hover over Research
 Output on the left-hand
 side panel, press the plus
 (+) that appears.



3 In the new Choose Submission window, click Import from file




4 To import from a BibTeX file, click the **BibTeX** window.


BibTex is a tool and a file format which are used to describe and process lists of references, mostly in conjunction with LaTeX documents.

5a Locate the BibTeX citation, e.g. by downloading from the journal's website. In this example, Springer allows you to download the BibTeX citation from the **Cite article** option.

NB: This is the journal website, and not an option in Pure.



5b Copy the BibTeX citation from your source and then paste it in the **Paste text** window in Pure. Finally, press **Import**



6 You will now see a citation for import. If this is correct, press **→ Import**

7 In the window that appears, set the original language of the contribution
