

Small change to UG3 course: Introduction to Vision and Robotics

Reduce number of courseworks in IVR (Maurice Fallon)

IVR is a 10 point course with 2 substantial coursework assignments.

Feedback on the course was in general very positive this year - except to say that the coursework workload was much too high for a 10 point course.

After discussing with staff teaching other vision and robotics courses, I/we propose to reduce the course assignments to one - likely the robotics one.

A summary of the proposal is:

- \* Reduce the number of courseworks from two to one.
- \* Change the assessment distribution from Exam/Coursework 60%/40% to 70%/30%.
