Deposit scheme: required for part of last year: 173 out of 219 deposits enrolled; 22 deferred to 2018; 5 did not meet conditions (refunded); 9 withdrew application and requested refund; 5 went to another uni; 5 pending (likely defer). Full scheme in place for 2018 entry.

Selection: move to gathered field. College will reject clearly unqualified candidates, and make offers to highly qualified ones, as they apply. Others will be gathered and considered in batches. After each selection deadline (7th Dec, 8th Feb, 19th Apr) a proportion of the places will be offered, using programme entry requirements (maths and programming made clearer for selection) + other achievements, skills and strength of personal statement. Others will either be rejected or carried forward. After 19th April, applications will be considered at our discretion, if places are still available. Target 350.

Scholarships: 2018 entry - 10 new scholarships @ £1000 for female applicants, to increase conversion (on merit), to go to fees

Of 20 scholarships for 2017 entry, UK/EU (10 x £1000) and for O/S (10 x £2000), all have now been taken up.
